RULES

It is the JKA SHOBU IPPON regulations that apply.

The groups will be discontinued according to the cup principle.

DIVISION INTO GROUPS

Individual classes regardless of degree:

- 12-13 years
- 14-15 years
- 16-17 years
- 18-20 years
- 21-34 years
- 35-44 years
- 45-54 years
- 55-99 years

No athlete can compete in more than two classes of kata and two classes of kumite, and only according to the following criteria:

- 12-13 years old can also compete in the following class: 14-15, but only in the kata class.
- 14-15 years old can also compete in the following class: 16 -17, but only in the kata class
- 16-17 years old can also compete in the following class: 18-20.
- 18-20 years old can also compete in the following class: 21-34.
- 21-34 years old can only compete in this class
- 35-44 years old can also compete in the following class: 21-34.
- 45-54 years old can also compete in the following class: 35-44.
- 55-99 years old can also compete in the following class: 45-54.

Team classes:

- 16-99 years: Team kata
- 18-99 år: Team kumite

Kata – Team:

Flag system up to final. In the final (4 teams) there is a point system. Minimum 2 katas. Can compete with the same kata in flag system for each round. Have to change kata in the final.

Kumite – Team:

Consists of 3 people and 1 person in reserve

PARTICIPATION

- The Nordic Championship is for athletes who turn 13 years old in 2026 and up.
- It is the age of the actual day of the competition that applies.

GENERAL

- Athletes must be Nordic citizens or have lived in Nordic countries for the last 12 months.
- A minimum of three athletes must start in all classes for those to be held.

REGISTRATION

Deadline: September 4 2026 at 23:59

- All registration must be done via event registration at:
 - Registration Event – JKA Norway
 - Referees and coaches must also be registered via the registration page.
 - Registration takes place directly in this link: <http://Register.jkanorway.no>
- Requirements for referees from Norway are at least referee license C license JKA WF. Referees from Sweden and Denmark follow their own criteria and are selected by their own committee in these countries.
- Obvious errors in the registration form that are discovered before the draw will be corrected by the administration.
- The countries must ensure that the registration is completed correctly and that the athletes are registered in the correct class(s). Errors/corrections that have occurred as a result of proven errors at the organizer will be corrected without a fee.

ENTRY FEE

NOK 400,- per athlete per class

NOK 600,- per team kata

NOK 600,- per team kumite

BEST OVERALL ATHLETE

The best female and best male athlete in the 21 – 34 age category, combined in kata and kumite, will each be awarded the prize for the Best Overall Athlete.

Awarded to the athlete who, in order of priority:

- Won a medal in both kata and kumite individually, including gold in one of the disciplines. If athlete 1 has his second medal in the denomination of silver, this athlete will be the winner if athlete 2 has his second medal in the denomination of bronze.
- If there is a basis for assessing several athletes equally, any team medals shall be considered.
- If there is a basis for assessing several athletes equally, the winner of individual gold in the kata class shall be awarded the best man prize.

IMPORTANT! INFORMATION FOR COACHES AND ATHLETES

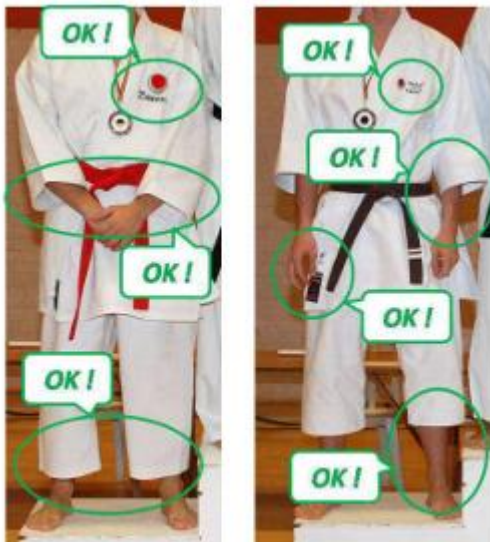
Equipment (protection gear) and karate gi

Each contestant is required to bring their own protection gear, which includes:

- Gloves: JKA-approved types (white only).
- Teeth Protection: Translucent mouthguards are mandatory.
- Chest Protectors: Recommended for female contestants.
- Groin Protection: Recommended for male contestants.

Contestants who wear contact lenses should bring a spare pair. In the event of a loss during a match, the contestant must replace the lens within 2 minutes.
